Stan Hogman died suddenly at his home on Tuesday 8th June. Stan was an active member of East Grinstead Lions Club from 1975 and will be remembered for his humour and quick wit. He was a great family man and often recalls how in the early days of the Club his family accompanied him to many of the events.
