You can of course approach friends or relatives to swim on your behalf if you are unable to find participants within your club, organisation or school.

The event is a great opportunity to raise funds for your club fund or chosen charity **without the stress of organizing an event yourself.**

As always, monies that are raised will be split **50/50** between your own approved club fund or chosen charity and local Lions charities.
